- ❖ Mail in completed application before project starts. Once the application is received a conservation specialist will call to schedule an appointment for pre-inspection. If the project is approved, then installation can begin.
- Tenants must get owner authorization in writing to receive rebate.
- Attach a copy of your most recent water bill for the address where the drought tolerant landscape will be installed. If you reside in an apartment complex, condominium or mobile home park, please contact your Homeowner's Association or manager for a copy of the water bill.

Residential Turf Removal Program Terms and Conditions San Diego County Service District

Residential Turf Removal Program Requirements:

- The project must be completed on properties located within California American Water's San Diego County service district.
- The applicant's water bill must be in good standing.
- Existing turf in project area must be living and regularly irrigated.
- If an in-ground irrigation system is used, it must be operational at the time of the pre-inspection.
- ❖ A pre/post inspection must be performed by a representative for California American Water Conservation before approval and rebate is issued.
- ❖ Lawns removed prior to pre-inspection are not eligible for rebates.
- Minimum project conversion area is 100 sq. ft.
- Maximum project conversion area is 750 sq. ft.

Requirements for the Completed Converted Area:

- 1. The area does not include any live turf.
- 2. The area must contain at least 5 plants per every 100 sq feet of converted area that are California native, drought tolerant plants and/or trees. Artificial turf is not an eligible alternative.
- 3. A drip and/or micro spray irrigation system must be installed if landscape contains newly planted native, non-invasive plants.
- 4. All exposed soil must be covered with a 2" layer of mulch, except in areas planted with creeping or rooting groundcovers or directly seeded.
- 5. Converted areas must be permeable to air and water (i.e. gravel, loose flagstone, decomposed granite). Weed barriers must be permeable. Concrete, plastic sheeting or other impermeable surfaces do not qualify.
- 6. Conversions must comply with all applicable laws, codes, policies, covenants, conditions, and restrictions.
- 7. Project site must be maintained for a minimum of 5 years, or for the duration of ownership of the property (whichever is shortest). Failure to meet this requirement may require customer to refund all or a portion of the rebate.
- Complete applications will be processed in the order received. This offer is subject to available funding.
- Only one Turf Removal rebate per address per year will be issued. Project must be completed within 120 days upon project approval.
- Landscape materials must be installed at the address identified on the application subsequent to submittal of this application.
- ❖ The rebate amount will not be higher than the cost of the materials. Labor, including Professional Labor, is not included. Rebates will never exceed the maximum amount allowed of \$1.50 per sq. ft. up to 750 sq. ft.
