BACKGROUND

California American Water filed Application (“A.”) 17-10-016 requesting the approval of the sale of Fruitridge Vista Water Company’s (“Fruitridge Vista”) assets to California American Water. The Commission approved the asset sale in Decision (“D.”) 19-12-038. California American Water closed the sale on February 4, 2020.

DISCUSSION

The requests contained in this advice letter relate to Ordering Paragraphs (“OP”) 2, 4, 6, 7 of D. 19-12-038, which state:

2. The authority for Cook Endeavors d/b/a Fruitridge Vista Water Company to sell and transfer to California American Water Company (Cal-Am) all of its utility assets is granted, conditioned on Cal-Am’s receipt of a temporary or final operating permit from the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water to operate the Fruitridge Vista Water Company.

4. California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) is authorized to assume all public utility responsibilities for the ownership and operation of the water utility operations of the Fruitridge system (subject to obtaining an operating permit as described in Law Paragraph 2 above). Cal-Am is authorized to operate the Fruitridge system under Fruitridge’s current rates.

6. California-American Water Company’s (Cal-AM) certificate of public convenience and necessity is amended so that Cal-Am may provide public utility water service to the current and future customers in Cook Endeavors d/b/a Fruitridge Vista Water Company’s service territory.

7. California-American Water Company may file Tier 1 Advice Letters to establish environmental/compliance and transaction costs memorandum accounts to track costs associated with the acquisition.

8. California-American Water Company may file a Tier 1 Advice Letter to establish a Meter Installation Memorandum Account.

Based on the foregoing OPs, California American Water submits the following requests to incorporate Fruitridge Vista’s rates, rules and maps into California American Water’s tariffs.

REQUEST

California-American Water obtained a permit from the State Water Resource Control Board (“SWRCB”) to operate the Fruitridge Vista system on November 22, 2019. This permit is provided as an attachment to this advice letter in compliance with OP 2 of D.19-12-038.

In accordance with OP 4 of D. 19-12-038, California American requests authority to integrate the Fruitridge Vista Water Company service area and rates into its existing tariffs and maps. Included in this integration is Fruitridge Vista’s existing State Revolving Fund surcharge. The SRF surcharge is outlined in Schedule No. CDPH.

In accordance with OP 7 of D.19-12-038, California American Water requests authorization to establish the Fruitridge Vista Transaction Costs Memorandum Account (FVTCMA) and to expand California American Water’s existing Memorandum Account for Environmental Improvement and Compliance Issues with Acquisitions to include Fruitridge Vista.

In accordance with OP 8 of D.19-12-038, California American Water requests authorization to establish a Meter Installation Memorandum Account (MIMA) for Fruitridge Vista.

SERVICE LIST

Pursuant to Section 4.3 of General Order No. 96-B, a copy of this advice letter is being sent to those entities listed in the attached service list. Copies of the detailed work papers and the documents supporting this Advice Letter have also been furnished to the Commission Staff.

EFFECTIVE DATE

California American Water submits this as a Tier 1 advice letter and requests an effective date of February 3, 2020, the date of closing.

RESPONSE OR PROTEST¹

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this AL. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds² are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

REPLIES³

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

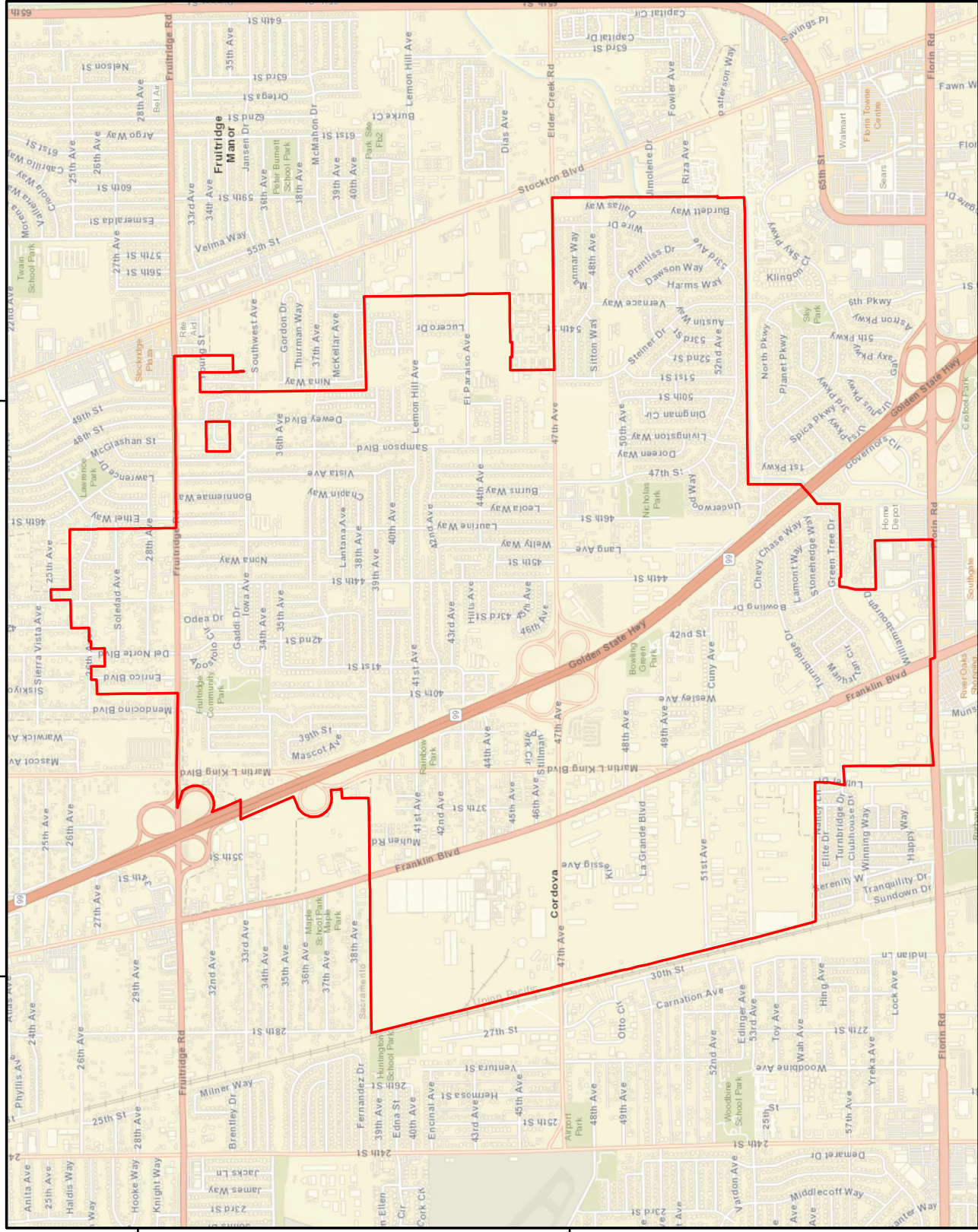
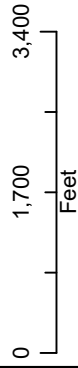
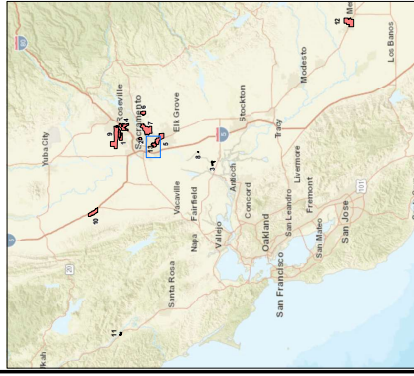

If payment is received after 3:00PM, service will not be restored until the next business day. All bills shall be subject to the PUC reimbursement fee as set forth in Schedule No. UF.

Untested Backflow Fees: Where the Utility elects to have an untested backflow assembly tested and, if needed, repaired or replaced, all charges incurred by the Utility from third party service providers will be added to the Customer bill of the account of record, and shall become due and payable as any other charge, including being part of any unpaid balance subject to late fees and discontinuance of service for non-payment.
