**Purpose:**

This advice letter filing requests recovery of intervenor compensation awarded to Planning and Conservation League Foundation.

**Background:**

In Decision (“D.”) 20-02-058, the Planning and Conservation League Foundation was awarded compensation for contribution in connection with D.18-09-017, which granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity for California American Water Company’s Monterey Peninsula Water Supply Project, including a 6.4 million-gallon-per-day desalination plant.

After issuance of D.18-09-017, Planning and Conservation League Foundation requested intervenor compensation. In D.20-02-058, the Commission granted Salinas Valley Water Coalition’s request and ordered the following:

1. *Planning and Conservation League Foundation shall be awarded \$210,136.88.*
2. *Within 30 days of the effective date of this decision, California-American Water Company shall pay Planning and Conservation League Foundation the total award. Payment of the award shall include compound interest at the rate earned on prime, three-month non-financial commercial paper as reported in Federal Reserve Statistical Release H.15, beginning February 3, 2019, the 75th day after the filing of Planning and Conservation League Foundation’s request, and continuing until full payment is made.<sup>1</sup>*

On February 27, 2020, California American Water issued a payment of \$215,019.80, which includes interest to Planning and Conservation League Foundation in accordance with D.20-02-058.

**Request:**

California American Water requests authorization to bill customers a meter surcharge to recover the \$215,019.80 compensation award for the Planning and Conservation League Foundation from all customer classes in the Monterey Service Area as ordered by D.20-02-058.

**Tier Designation:**

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No.96-B and this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

**Effective Date:**

California American Water requests an effective date of November 22, 2020.

**NOTICE:**

Pursuant to Section 4.3 of General Order No. 96-B, a copy of this advice letter is being provided to those entities listed in the attached "SERVICE LIST PURSUANT TO SECTION 4.3 OF G.O. NO. 96-B." Per guidance from the California Public Utilities Commission's Water Division, during the Covid-19 pandemic advice letters will only be delivered electronically to the service list. Hardcopy advice letters will be mailed as soon as administrative staff are able to return to CAW offices. Copies of the detailed workpapers and the documents supporting this Advice Letter have also been furnished to the Commission Staff.

**PROTEST OR RESPONSES:**

Anyone may submit a response or protest for this AL. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds<sup>2</sup> are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;  
or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

**REPLIES**

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.
