ADVICE LETTER NO. 1321

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

California-American Water Company (California American Water) (U210W) submits this advice letter, including the following attached tariffs applicable to its Monterey Service Area:

**Purpose:**

This advice letter filing requests recovery of intervenor compensation awarded to Public Water Now.

**Background:**

In Decision (“D.”) 20-08-040, Public Water Now was awarded compensation for its contribution in connection with D.18-09-017, which granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity for California American Water Company’s Monterey Peninsula Water Supply Project, including a 6.4 million-gallon-per-day desalination plant.

Specifically in D.20-08-040, the Commission granted Public Water Now’s request as follows:

1. *Public Water Now shall be awarded \$9,850.40.*
2. *Within 30 days of the effective date of this decision, California-American Water Company shall pay Public Water Now the total award. Payment of the award shall include compound interest at the rate earned on prime, three-month non-financial commercial paper as reported in Federal Reserve Statistical Release H.15, beginning February 3, 2019, the 75th day after the filing of Public Water Now’s request, and continuing until full payment is made.<sup>1</sup>*

On September 18, 2020, California American Water issued a payment of \$10,094.78, which includes interest to Public Water Now in accordance with D.20-08-040.

**Request:**

California American Water requests authorization to bill customers a meter surcharge to recover the \$10,094.78 compensation award to Public Water Now, from all customer classes in the Monterey Service Area as ordered by D.20-08-040. Clarify applicable service area special condition language on tariffs CA-4 and CA-4H for Monterey related intervenor compensation surcharges.

These tariffs are submitted pursuant to General Order No.96-B and this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 2 designation.

California American Water requests an effective date of February 14, 2020.

**NOTICE:**

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;  
or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

**REPLIES**

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.
