We are also committed to supporting organizations that make our communities a better place to live and work. That's why we're proud to have provided over \$400,770 in funding to 55 organizations to benefit the well-being of our customers, communities, and watersheds. Making an impact across the state is one more way we help keep life flowing!

GIVING BACK: MORE THAN \$400,700

We donated \$326,506 to organizations in our communities through grants, scholarships, general charitable contributions and programming support and \$74,264 to assist customers in paying their water bill.



Help to Others Program: \$74,264 to fund our customer assistance program. Since 2000, we have been assisting customers experiencing financial hardship to help keep their water services flowing. In 2023, 427 grants totaling \$71,400 were provided to households in need.
